

Agenda: Research and Development Cell Initiatives

Dr. Sangeeta Singh initiated the discussion by highlighting the importance of aligning our Research and Development (R&D) initiatives with the goals of the National Education Policy (NEP) for creating a self-reliant India. The members engaged in a thorough discussion about the initiative to fund or waive off registration fees for students and research scholars participating in national and international conferences organized by the college. The following points were discussed:

Funding Source: Members explored potential sources of funding for this initiative, including utilizing the R&D budget or seeking external grants.

Criteria for Eligibility: It was suggested that eligibility criteria should be established, ensuring that beneficiaries are actively involved in research projects and publications. The members emphasized the importance of linking our R&D initiatives with the NEP's vision of self-reliance and self-sufficiency. It was agreed that R&D projects should be designed to address societal challenges and promote innovation and technology development in line with the NEP's goals. It was proposed and agreed that a subcommittee be formed to further investigate and develop the details of the fee waiver initiative, including eligibility criteria, application procedures, and funding sources. The members also discussed the need for continuous communication and collaboration between the R&D Cell and other departments and committees to ensure that research projects and initiatives align with the overall academic and institutional objectives.
